2. Individual online acceleration procedure


What does this mean?

The final activities in the MicroHUB project were aimed at providing a tailored approach for supporting emerging, new and current craft entrepreneurs in their process of setting up or the transformation of their businesses. This final project result had the objective of implementing a individual online acceleration procedure for entrepreneurs using digital tools for communication, providing them services for supporting tailored business plan creation and mentoring.

How was this organized?


The mentoring was carried out in Slovakia, Ireland, Bulgaria, Greece, Poland, Sweden and Malta. In each of these countries, 5 rural mentees participated in the mentorship. They were guided by a mentor, supporting them in about digital entrepreneurship, learning answering their questions or addressing problems that the mentees brought up. The roles of the 2 mentors per country were taken by experienced trainers in entrepreneurial skills and business. The running time for a mentorship was 20 hours. All this with the support of the MicroHUB project results.

Prior to the mentoring, piloting of the MicroHUB online tool was organized. This included testing the e-course and engaging with the e-catalogue.

The publication of the Guide to become a Mentor is one of the deliverables of the individual online acceleration procedure. The guide is intended to help mentors who specialise in instructing crafters and artisans, as well as to offer useful information and resources for crafters and artisans themselves.
